## U.S. Air Force Fact Sheet 127<sup>th</sup> Logistics Readiness Squadron

The 127<sup>th</sup> Logistics Readiness Squadron is one of the most diverse work places in the 127<sup>th</sup> Wing, providing Transportation, Aerial Port, Supply and Readiness support to the 127<sup>th</sup> Wing. The 127<sup>th</sup> LRS is a component of the 127<sup>th</sup> Mission Support Group, 127 Wing, Michigan Air National Guard. The squadron is stationed at Selfridge Air National Guard Base, Mich.



### History

The origins of the current 127<sup>th</sup> LRS can be traced back to the 191<sup>st</sup> and the 127<sup>th</sup> Resource Management Squadrons. Each of these units was tasked to work independently from each other while supporting their own designated aircraft and mission. With the consolidation of the 127<sup>th</sup> Wing in 1996, the need for separate squadrons was eliminated, paving the way for the eventual merger of the two units and creation of the 127<sup>th</sup> Logistics Squadron. Placed under the 127<sup>th</sup> Maintenance Group, the 127<sup>th</sup> LS continued to evolve over the next few years with both gains and losses to its makeup. Eventually, after losing the Contracting Flight and gaining the Aerial Port Flight, the 127<sup>th</sup> LS realigned again under the 127<sup>th</sup> Mission Support Group and became known as the 127<sup>th</sup> Logistics Readiness Squadron.
