Colonel (Dr.) Sidney N Martin is Commander of the 127th Medical Group (ACC), Selfridge Air National Guard Base, MI. He serves as the senior medical officer and as the advisor to the 127th Wing commander. Colonel Martin ensures maximized operational health and combat readiness. He helps shape medical capability through plans, operational policies, guidance, oversight, consultation, financial management and training. Colonel Martin is responsible for the health and fitness of over 1500 traditional and AGR members in three separate commands.

Colonel Martin is a Senior Flight Surgeon with 273 flying hours and has flown 15 combat sorties. He has deployed in support of Operations Desert Storm, Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom.

Colonel Martin received a direct commission as a Reserve Officer of the United States Air Force while still in orthopedic residency training. Following his commissioning in July of 1986 he was assigned to the 927th Medical Squadron, Selfridge ANGB. After completing his residency he transferred to the 169th Tactical Clinic, McEntire ANGB, SC where he served as a flight surgeon and as the Squadron Medical Element for the 157th Fighter squadron. Colonel Martin received his commission in the Michigan Air National Guard in December of 2002 and has served as the Chief of Professional Services and the Chief of Aerospace Medicine since joining the 127th Medical Group.
