127th Wing Key Accomplishments

(Fiscal Year 2013)

Personnel

- Deployments to Pacific, European and Central Command areas.
- 296 Airmen participated in major exercises for 3,594 man-days.

Facilities

- Took possession of \$8M Munitions storage facility.
- Took possession of \$5.8M Fighter Operations building.
- Began design work on new jet fuel storage/hydrant system. Construction planned for FY15.

Aircraft

- Served as successful prototype test site for KC-135 large aircraft infrared countermeasure, LAIRCM, system.

Base/Community-wide

- Hosted visit & local hearings by the National Commission of the Structure of the Air Force.
- Ribbon-cutting for U.S. Navy-led Joint Reserve Intelligence Center-Detroit, employing 250 military analysts.
- Hosted Macomb County Health Dept. disaster readiness exercise.

127th Wing

- Host unit. Wing commander serves as base commander
- Reports to 3 Air Force Major Commands — ACC, AMC & AFSOC
- Flies fighter (A-10 and air-refueling (KC-135) aircraft
- Approximately 1,700 personnel

Other units at Selfridge Air National Guard Base

- Tenant commands at Selfridge
- Army, Navy, Marines, Coast Guard & Homeland Security
- National Guard, Reserve, Active Duty & Civilian personnel
- Approximately 2,800 personnel
