



## ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

### Cultural Resources Management Program

---

The May 2011 Cultural Resources Survey documents the results of the most recent cultural resources survey conducted at 127WG, Selfridge ANG Base, MI. The survey and evaluation was completed to identify prehistoric and historic archaeological resources, document architectural resources, and evaluate both types of resources in order to make preliminary determinations of eligibility for listing on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).

The May 2011 Cultural Resources Survey identified the following cultural resources and recommendations to assist the 127WG, Selfridge ANGB in complying with applicable federal and AF requirements:

Historic facilities are listed in the Selfridge ANGB/State of Michigan, Historic Preservation Office(Sep 2002) Programmatic Agreement —(refer to ICRMP for authoritative listing)

The 127WG Selfridge ANG Base Environmental Management Office (EMO) maintains an Integrated Cultural Resources Management Plan (ICRMP) as the operational control to manage their Cultural Resources, which has been approved by the State Historic Preservation Office. The 127WG, Selfridge ANGB ICRMP provides guidelines in preserving, restoring, and maintaining the historic and cultural environment present at the installation.
