



# ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

## Hazardous Waste Management Program

---

The focus of the Hazardous Waste program at the 127th Wing is to identify sources of hazardous waste (waste streams) and assist base personnel with the proper and safe handling of all hazardous waste, which also includes the provision of appropriate training. It is our aim to ensure the proper and safe disposal of all regulated RCRA waste. The goal is to minimize the amount of hazardous waste being disposed and to reduce costs and impact on the environment. The 127th Wing is a Large Quantity Generator.

To address Hazardous Waste at Selfridge ANG Base, The Hazardous Waste Management Plan (HWMP), an installation-developed document that provides guidance to personnel who work with hazardous waste (HW), sets local management procedures for managing HW and preventing pollution. The plan incorporates current USAF (AFI 32-7042, 32-7045, 32-7080, 32-7086 and AFP 32-7043), ANG, EPA, OSHA, state, federal (29 CFR Parts 1900-1910, 40 CFR Parts 260-299, 49 CFR Parts, 100-177), and local requirements regarding the management of HW as they relate to environmental protection and worker safety during operations conducted at this installation.

The Hazardous Waste Management Plan (HWMP) is a base-specific operational control that provides guidance to personnel who work with hazardous waste and sets management procedures for hazardous waste management and pollution prevention on base. It is applicable to ANG and tenant operations conducted at Selfridge ANG Base. The plan has been developed to ensure that the installation has guidance pertaining to applicable aspects of HW management to facilitate compliance with all federal, State, and local regulations. This plan addresses key issues in implementing the complex area of HW management required by RCRA, as enforced by the EPA, at federal facilities. The plan also addresses mandatory requirements as set forth in the state HW management regulations. Michigan has been authorized by the EPA to administer a HW regulatory program and to enforce the RCRA requirements.
