



ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

Natural Resources Management Program

This program seeks to manage natural resources on Air National Guard (ANG) installations in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and standards through the development of an integrated natural resource management plan (INRMP). At Selfridge, this includes the management of wetlands, floodplains, coastal and marine resources, forests, outdoor recreation, land, invasive species, threatened and endangered species, fish and wildlife while taking into consideration Bird/wildlife aircraft strike hazard (BASH) concerns, budgeting, public relations, and area specific training as needed. Having a valid and current INRMP is required to obtain funds necessary to conduct natural resource surveys, analysis, monitoring, planning, and support actions recommended within the installations INRMP.

The INRMP is a “living” document, subject to periodic updates or changes, which integrates all aspects of natural resources management at Selfridge ANGB. Proper utilization of this Plan for the conservation of natural resources should not impair the ability of the installation to perform its mission. The Plan was written in accordance with all applicable USAF and DOD policies, directives, and instructions, and was reviewed and approved by Selfridge ANGB, the ANG Natural Resources Program Manager, the USFWS, and the MDNRE.
