



## ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

### Solid Waste Diversion Management Program

---

Selfridge ANG Base has developed the solid waste operational control within an Integrated Solid Waste Management (ISWM) Plan, which provides procedures for the collection and methods of disposal, recycling and/or recovery for solid waste and recycled materials. The ISWM Plan contains guidance for managing municipal solid waste (MSW), compost materials, construction and demolition (C&D) debris, and industrial solid waste (ISW).

Solid waste materials identified for recycling at the Base include: cardboard, paper (office, news), magazines, phonebooks, glass, plastic, used oil, used antifreeze, used toner cartridges, CDs/DVDs, used electronic items, wood pallets/scrap, used tires, scrap metal (both ferrous and nonferrous metal, including fired brass casings & aluminum flare tubes), used batteries (lead acid, lithium, nickel-cadmium, metal halide), and used fluorescent lamps. In addition, this plan establishes the collection points for the accumulation and segregation of such materials. In the ISWM Plan is a section on the Qualified Recycling Program (QRP), which provides procedures for the turn-in and local sale process and the financial management process for accounting of funds generated from the sale of recycled materials. This plan applies to all 127th Wing personnel, in addition to DoD tenants and contractors.
