U.S. Air Force Fact Sheet 127th Mission Support Group

The 127th Mission Support Group provides a wide variety of local and deployment support service in response to the local and global mission needs of the Michigan Air National Guard and the U.S. Air Force. Assigned to the 127th Wing, the 127th MSG provides personnel, communications, facilities, security, logistics and other support services at Selfridge Air National Guard.



The 127th MSG is comprised of five squadrons, each assigned to a specific area of expertise required to operate an air base. The combined duties of the 127th MSG are often compared to the services provided by local government in a civilian sector. Those squadrons are:

- 127th Civil Engineer Squadron
- 127th Security Forces Squadron
- 127th Logistics Readiness Squadron
- 127th Communications Squadron
- 127th Force Support Squadron

In addition to providing services to the 127th Wing at Selfridge, the 127th MSG is responsible for providing basic infrastructure support, such as security, firefighting, road maintenance and other services to the 44 tenant commands and more than 5,000 personnel assigned at Selfridge.

The 127th MSG also includes the National Guard Bureau's Contracting Center of Excellence and the NGB Civilian Human Resource Office, both of which are based at Selfridge.

In all, more than 500 personnel are assigned to the 127th MSG.
