National Guard Bureau – Air National Guard

The National Guard Bureau (NGB), the Air National Guard (ANG) headquarters, at Andrews Air Force Base, in Maryland, is responsible for funding, contracting, and oversight of environmental remediation efforts at ANG installations in the United States under the Environmental Restoration Program (ERP). The NGB is responsible for the management of the investigation, remediation, and closure of potentially contaminated and contaminated sites in accordance with United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Department of Defense (DoD), Air Force, and ANG regulations, directives, and instructions. An ERP management representative ensures the proper remediation techniques are followed and closure of sites occur to protect human health and the environment.

The Selfridge Air National Guard Base (SANGB) environmental management office facilitates local information from the NGB to the public, local contractors, and other organizations. The office provides support for information requests from the public and contractors to the NGB on various site activities and plans, and coordinates local base resources for remediation activities.

Background

SANGB has a long history dating back to 1 July 1917, as an Army air installation. Past and present activities at Selfridge have resulted in the generation and disposal of potentially hazardous waste and materials that are commonly associated with industrial and military operations. These include activities pertaining to, solid waste disposal, fire training, firing ranges, explosive ordnance disposal, aircraft maintenance, and ground support vehicle maintenance. In 1982, the ANG began conducting environmental restoration activities to address environmental site contamination on the installation, and numerous investigations, studies, and remedial actions have been completed during this period. To date, the ANG and the MDEQ have been working co-operatively to address the state regulator's specific environmental requirements at the installation. The majority of sites have received approval for no further action from the MDEQ. However, several sites are still subject to future investigations, long term monitoring, and ongoing remediation activities.
