The Guardsmen at Selfridge ANG Base have been a cornerstone in this diverse community which supports its military and will welcome you as well.



Selfridge Air National Guard Base is located approximately 20 miles north of metro Detroit on the western shoreline of Lake St. Clair in Harrison Township. Selfridge is home of many Department of Defense and Department of Homeland Security units, including the Air National Guard, Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Customs and Border Protection, and Border Patrol. Selfridge takes pride in being the only reserve forces base to have permanently assigned units from five of the uniformed services. The Michigan Air National Guard's 127th Wing is the host unit at the base supporting more than 70 tenant units, a variety of flying operations, and a force of more than 5,000 personnel. The 127th Wing has groups reporting to Air Combat Command (A-10s) and Air Mobility Command (KC-135s).

"The mission of the 127th Wing is to provide trained, equipped and motivated air refueling, fighter and support resources serving the community, state and nation."

The 127th Wing effectively triples mission capability by utilizing a single cost-efficient mission support group dedicated to supporting two major commands, including two distinctly separate flying missions the A-10 and the KC-135. Selfridge's airfield and facilities are constructed and maintained to a level that will allow for expansion, improvement, and future missions. With the infrastructure capacity and supportive community, our vision is to bring active association units to both the tanker and fighter sides of the wing.

Our Place in the DoD



ABOUT SELFRIDGE AIR NATIONAL GUARD BASE

Our origins date back to the dawn of aviation, when U.S. Army Lt. Thomas Selfridge, perished in 1908 while flying in a demonstration aircraft with Orville Wright, making him the first military casualty of flight.

In 1917, Henry B. Joy, president of the Packard Motor Company, leased his rural airstrip to Army for training in preparation for entry into World War I. On July 8, 1917, Lt. Byron Q. Jones made Selfridge's first military flight in a Curtiss JN-4 "Jenny."

During World War II, pilots and maintenance personnel of the famed Tuskegee Airmen, a unit comprised of African-American Airmen, trained here,

leading the way toward the end of racial segregation in the military.

During the Cold War era, Nike missiles were stationed here to guard the industrial might of the Detroit region.

The 127th Wing flew F-16 Fighting Falcon patrol missions over the Great Lakes region within hours of the 9/11 terrorist attacks and maintained that 24-hour mission until 2008, when the Wing transitioned to the KC-135 Stratotanker and A-10 Thunderbolt II airframes.

GETTING ON BASE

It is DOD policy to use the following criteria in granting visitor access to Selfridge Air National Guard Base. If you or a guest meet any of the following criteria, your access will be denied:

- Wanted by federal, state, local or other civil law enforcement
- Convicted of:
 - espionage
 - sabotage
 - treason
 - terrorism
 - murder
 - firearms violation
 - explosives violation
 - any type of sexual offense
 - armed robbery
 - trafficking in persons
 - drug distribution or possession with intent to sell
- Appear on any federal/state agency watch or hit lists for criminal behavior or terrorist activity
- Listed on the FBI's violent persons file and/or the national sex offender registry
- Barred from access to a federal installation or stand alone facility
- Unable to validate your claimed identity
- Known to be or reasonably suspected of being a terrorist or belonging to an organization with known terrorism links
- Knowingly and willfully engaged in acts designed to overthrow the U.S. government by force

HOUSE RULES

CONCEALED PISTOL LICENSE

Guests visiting Michigan National Guard installations and facilities are authorized to carry concealed, personal weapons if they are licensed to do so. This does not apply to federal tenant units residing on Selfridge ANGB.

Openly carrying personal weapons is prohibited at Selfridge Air National Guard Base.

DRONES PROHIBITED

Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) are not authorized at Selfridge Air National Guard Base. Moreover, it is **illegal** to fly an unmanned aircraft in this area without prior approval from the FAA and proper certification.


TRAFFIC

LOCAL AREA TRAFFIC INFORMATION

Michigan uses a traffic pattern uncommon in other parts of the U.S, known as the, "Michigan Left." On roads with a divided median, left turns are generally not permitted at the intersection. Instead, drivers must proceed through the intersection, make a U-turn and then make a right turn onto their intended crossroad.

"Michigan Left"

The red line indicates the proper traffic flow for making a left turn onto a crossroad from a divided road. The green line indicates the proper traffic flow for making a left turn onto a divided road from a crossroad. Intersections that have Michigan Lefts will be marked with a sign several hundred feet before the intersection, giving drivers time to move to the proper lane. When you are in a turnaround lane, you may make a left turn on a steady red light if oncoming traffic is clear, after coming to a complete stop. If you are going straight across from a turnaround lane, you must wait for a green light.


